HOUSE AMENDMENT "A" to H. P. 1450, L. D. 1826, Bill,
"AN ACT Permitting the Town of Madawaska to Join School Administrative
District No. 33 Under Certain Conditions."

Amend said Bill in the 3rd line (same in L.D.) after the
enacting clause by inserting after the words "directed to" the
words and punctuation 'initiate, negotiate and'

Further amend said Bill by striking out all of the last 2
sentences in the first paragraph after the enacting clause and
inserting in place thereof the following:

'The town clerk of the municipality shall immediately file a return with
the State Board of Education certifying the results of the vote
and the secretary of the School Administrative District shall certify
the results of the district vote. If the board finds that a majority
of the voters voting on the question in Madawaska and a majority of
the voters voting on the question in district No. 33 have approved
the terms of the agreement, the board shall make a finding of fact
to that effect and shall forthwith issue an amended Certificate of
Organization of the enlarged district.'
