SENATE AMENDMENT "A" to H.P. 1451, L.D. 1827, Bill, "AN ACT Permitting the Town of Winterport to Join School Administrative District #22 or School Administrative District #56 Under Certain Conditions."

Amend said Bill in the 3rd line after the enacting clause (same in L.D.) by inserting after the words "directed to" the words and punctuation 'initiate, negotiate and'

Further amend said Bill by striking out all of the last sentence of the first paragraph after the enacting clause (same in L.D.) and inserting in place thereof the following: 'If the board finds that a majority of the voters voting on the question in Winterport and a majority of the voters voting on the question in either district #22 or district #56 have approved the terms of the agreement, the board shall make a finding of fact to that effect and shall forthwith issue an amended Certificate of Organization which shall be conclusive evidence of the lawful organization of the enlarged district.'
