SENATE AMENDMENT "A" to H. P. 1453, L. D. 1831, Bill, "AN ACT to Appropriate Funds for School Subsidies."

Amend said Bill by striking out all of the Title and inserting in place thereof the following Title: 'AN ACT Relating to Apportionment of Funds for School Subsidies.'

Further amend said Bill by striking out everything after the enacting clause and inserting in place thereof the following:

'Apportionment for school subsidies. The apportionment of state aid for the period beginning January 1, 1970 and ending June 30, 1970, shall be made on a monthly basis and shall be 1/2 of the apportionment computed for the first year of the biennium. The apportionment to each administrative unit shall be distributed during the last full week of each month, except that the January 1970 payment may be paid as soon as funds are available.'
