IN THE YEAR OF OUR LORD NINETEEN HUNDRED

AN ACT Relating to Distribution of Funds for School Subsidies.

Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine, as follows :

Apportionment for school subsidies. The apportionment of state aid for the period beginning January 1, 1970 and ending June 30, 1970, shall be made on a monthly basis. The apportionment to each administrative unit shall be distributed during the last full week of each month, except that the January 1970 payment may be paid as soon as funds are available. Any administrative unit shall receive $\frac{1}{2}$ of the amount computed under chapter 496 of the public laws of 1969 during the first 6 months of 1970. If sufficient funds are not available, the funds shall be prorated to each administrative unit to whatever extent is required to stay within the proceeds of the \$22,000,000 bond issue.
