SENATE AMENDMENT "A" to H. P. 1458, L. D. 1834, Bill, "AN ACT to Regulate Site Location of Development Substantially Affecting Environment."

Amend said Bill by striking out all of that part designated "§488." of section 2 (same in L. D.) and inserting in place thereof the following:

'§488. Applicability

This subchapter shall not apply to any development in existence of in possession of applicable state or local licenses to operate or under construction on January 1, 1970 or to any development the construction and operation of which has been specifically authorized by the Legislature prior to the effective date hereof, or to public service corporation transmission lines. After the commission shall have established ambient air quality standards and emission standards for any air quality region pursuant to sections 584 and 585, this subchapter shall not apply with respect to any development proposing to locate in the appropriate zoned area of any municipality in such air quality region which had adopted a municipal plan and zoning and subdivision ordinances based thereon.'
