SENATE AMENDMENT "B" to H.P. 1458, L.D. 1834, Bill, "AN ACT to Regulate Site Location of Development Substantially Affecting Environment."

Amend said Bill in that part designated "§ 488" of section 2 by inserting in the 7th line after the word and punctuation "hereof," (6th line in L.D.) the following: 'or to any development for excavating natural resources which prior to January 1, 1970 has purchased land for a manufacturing site, conducted feasibility studies relative to the processing of a raw material into a marketable product and to determine the size and design of a manufacturing plant and has explored for minerals,'
