STATE OF MAINE

IN THE YEAR OF OUR LORD NINETEEN HUNDRED AND SEVENTY

AN ACT Relating to Interest Earned on Investments of Special Revenue Funds.

Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine, as follows:

R. S., T. 5, § 135, amended. The 3rd sentence of the first paragraph of section 135 of Title 5 of the Revised Statutes is amended to read as follows:

Interest earned on such investments of moneys shall be credited to the respective funds, except that interest earned on investments of special revenue funds, other than those of the Department of Inland Fisheries and Game, shall be credited to the General Fund of the State.
