SENATE AMENDMENT "A" to H.P. 1465, L.D. 1839, Bill,  
"AN ACT on Tax Relief to the Elderly."

Amend said Bill by inserting at the beginning of the  
first line the underlined abbreviation and figure 'Sec. 1.'

Further amend said Bill by adding at the end the  
following:

'Sec. 2. R. S., T. 36, §§ 657-659, repealed. Sections  
657 to 659 of Title 36 of the Revised Statutes, as enacted by  
chapter 444 of the public laws of 1969, are repealed.'
