SENATE AMENDMENT "B" to H. P. 1466, L. D. 1840, Bill, "AN ACT Providing for the Regulation of Motion Pictures for Exhibition to Minors."

Amend said Bill by adding at the end of section 1 the following:

'§ 665. Enforcement

No person shall publicly show or exhibit a motion picture which, in whole or in part, depicts nudity, sexual conduct, sexual excitement or sado-masochistic abuse and which is harmful to minors unless a duly authorized police officer, sheriff or deputy sheriff is present during such showing or exhibition. Such officer, sheriff or deputy sheriff shall enforce this chapter. Any person publicly showing or exhibiting such a motion picture shall be responsible for payment for the attendance and services of such officer, sheriff or deputy sheriff.'
