SENATE AMENDMENT "A" to S. P. 663, L.D. 1845, Bill, "AN ACT Repealing the Interest on Unissued Bonds for Water Pollution Abatement."

Amend said Bill by inserting before the enacting clause the following:

'Preamble. Two-thirds of both Houses of the Legislature deeming it necessary in accordance with Section 14, Article IX of the Constitution to repeal the interest on unissued bonds for water pollution abatement.'

Further amend said Bill in the 2nd and 3rd lines (3rd in L.D.) from the end of the first paragraph of section 3 by striking out the words and figures "a special state-wide election to be held on June 15, 1970" and inserting in place thereof the following: 'the next general state-wide election'
