IN THE YEAR OF OUR LORD NINETEEN HUNDRED SEVENTY-ONE

AN ACT Relating to Availability of Statistical Reports of Employment Security Commission

Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine, as follows:

R. S., T. 26, § 1082, sub-§ 7, amended. Subsection 7 of section 1082 of Title 26 of the Revised Statutes is amended by adding at the end a new paragraph to read as follows:

Notwithstanding any other provision of this subsection, statistical information, compiled or to be compiled, obtained pursuant to the administration of this chapter shall be available, upon request of any municipality or Member of the Legislature, for the purpose of determining the number of unemployed persons in the particular municipality.

STATEMENT OF FACT

The information desired by a municipality under this bill will enable a municipality to better plan its budget for welfare needs.
