COMMITTEE AMENDMENT "A " to S. P. 4, L. D. 18, Bill, "AN ACT
Relating to Age Limit for Motor Vehicle Operator Licenses."

Amend said Bill by striking out in the 4th line of section
1 (same in L. D.) the underlined figure "17" and inserting
in place thereof the underlined figure '16'

Further amend said Bill by striking out in the 5th line
of section 2 (4th line of L. D.) the underlined figure "17"
and inserting in place thereof the underlined figure '16'

Further amend said Bill by striking out all of section 3.

Further amend said Bill by striking out in the 4th line
of section 4 (3rd line of L. D.) the figure "17" and inserting
in place thereof the figure '16'

Further amend said Bill by renumbering section 4 to be
section 3.

Statement of Fact

The purpose of this amendment is to allow licenses at age
16 and to allow for the learning between ages 15 and 16.
