**AN ACT Authorizing Secretary of State to Issue Summary of
Motor Vehicle Laws to Tourists.**

Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine, as follows:

Sec. 1. R. S., T. 29, § 56, amended. Section 56 of Title 29 of the Revised Statutes is amended by adding a new paragraph to read as follows:

The Secretary of State may issue a summary of motor vehicle laws and rules and regulations in pamphlet form for distribution to tourists at such locations as he may direct.

Sec. 2. Appropriation. There is appropriated from the General Fund to the Office of the Secretary of State the sum of \$2,000 to carry out the purposes of this Act.

STATEMENT OF FACT

This legislation provides information to acquaint out-of-state visitors with Maine laws and regulations to help them avoid infractions of law and subsequent apprehension.
