RESOLVE, Regulating Fishing for Salmon at Sebago Lake Station.

Regulating Salmon Fishing at Sebago Lake Station, Cumberland County.
Resolved: That the Commissioner of Inland Fisheries and Game be authorized and directed to issue a rule and regulation opening Sebago Lake Station, Cumberland County, to fly fishing only for salmon and establishing a daily bag limit of one salmon per day during the month of October per year; such fishing to be from the shore only in an area bounded on the west by the Sebago Lake Station dock and on the east by the Portland Water District's pumping station on Route 35, these 2 points to be designated by a red post at each extremity.

STATEMENT OF FACT

This resolve permits salmon fishing at Sebago Lake Station under certain restrictions.
