AN ACT Providing Handrails for Stairs in Public Buildings.

Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine, as follows:

R. S., T. 25, § 2451-A, additional. Title 25 of the Revised Statutes is amended by adding a new section 2451-A to read as follows:

§ 2451-A. Handrails

Every outside stair located in any building intended temporarily or permanently for public use shall have a proper handrail on at least one side.

STATEMENT OF FACT

The purpose of this bill is for added protection for people using public buildings by providing a handrail on every outside stair in such buildings.
