**AN ACT Relating to Catering at Events and Gatherings of Certain
Charitable Organizations.**

Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine, as follows:

R. S., T. 28, § 801-A, sub-§ 6, additional. Section 801-A of Title 28 of the Revised Statutes, as enacted by chapter 314 of the public laws of 1969, is amended by adding a new subsection 6 to read as follows:

6. Exemption. This section shall not apply to planned events or gatherings conducted by charitable organizations. Charitable organizations shall mean any group of benevolent, philanthropic, patriotic or eleemosynary persons purporting to be such.

STATEMENT OF FACT

The purpose of this bill is to exempt charitable organizations from the catering liquor law.
