RESOLVE, Designating a Certain Highway in York County as James W. Cleary Memorial Highway.

Designation of a certain highway in York County. Resolved: That in recognition of his unselfish services to his community, state and nation by James W. Cleary, the section of State Highway 4 beginning at the junction of Routes 4 and 236 in South Berwick, proceeding through a section of the Town of South Berwick and ending at the junction of Routes 4 and 9 in North Berwick be named the James W. Cleary Memorial Highway.

STATEMENT OF FACT

James W. Cleary gave his life for his country as a soldier in South Vietnam. It is only fitting that this legislation be passed to honor his memory. The cost will be borne by the Town Council of South Berwick.
