HOUSE AMENDMENT " A " to S. P. 13, L. D. 41, Bill, "AN
ACT Relating to Legislative Counsel or Agents."

Amend said Bill in the Title by inserting after the
word "Agents" and before the period the words 'and Members of
the Legislature'

Further amend said Bill by inserting at the end of section 1,
the following:

'Sec. 2. R. S., T. 3, § 5, additional. Title 3 of the
Revised Statutes is amended by adding a new section 5 to read
as follows:

§ 5. Income

It shall be the duty of every legislator to file a state-
ment in the office of the Secretary of State within 30 days
after the convening of the Legislature showing the legislator's
annual gross income for the preceding year and the sources
thereof.'

Statement of Fact

The purpose of this amendment is to require the disclosure
of each legislator's income and the sources from which it is
derived so that the voters of the State of Maine may have,
as a matter of public record, a source that they may utilize
in ascertaining what interest a legislator may have in matters
before the Legislature.
