SENATE AMENDMENT "A" to S. P. 14, L. D. 42, Bill, "AN ACT  
Repealing the Poll Tax."

Amend said Bill by inserting at the beginning of the first  
line after the enacting clause (same in L. D.) the underlined  
abbreviation and figure 'Sec. 1.'

Further amend said Bill by inserting at the end the  
following:

'Sec. 2. Effective date. This Act shall become effective  
March 31, 1972.'
