AN ACT Relating to Notification to Panel of Mediators in Labor Disputes.

Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine, as follows:

R. S., T. 26, § 882-A, additional. Title 26 of the Revised Statutes is amended by adding a new section 882-A to read as follows:

§ 882-A. Notification

The employer, union and employees shall notify the Panel of Mediators whenever new contracts are to be negotiated between the employer and the employees or whenever a dispute arises between the parties threatening interruption of work, or under both conditions.

STATEMENT OF FACT

The purpose of this legislation is to advise the Panel of Mediators whenever harmonious labor relations between employers and employees are threatened so that the panel may be in the position to avoid work stoppages.
