SENATE AMENDMENT "B" to S. P. 16, L. D. 44, Bill, "AN ACT  
Increasing Minimum Wages."

Amend said Bill by striking out in the 10th line (8th line  
of L. D.) the following: "\$2 per hour starting October 15, 1969-  
1971" and inserting in place thereof the following: '\$1.80 per  
hour ~~starting from~~ starting from October 15, 1969 1971, to October 15, 1972 and  
thereafter \$2 per hour'

Further amend said Bill by striking out in the last line, before  
the Statement of Fact, the underlined figure "\$2" and inserting  
in place thereof the underlined figure '\$1.80'

Statement of Fact

The purpose of this amendment is to provide a graduated increase  
in the minimum wage. Effective October 15, 1971 the minimum wage  
will be \$1.80 per hour, and on October 15, 1972, it will be \$2.

Nursing home and hospital employees will have a similar step  
increase except that the maximum for such employees will be \$1.80  
per hour.
