

SENATE AMENDMENT "B " to S. P. 16, L. D. 44, Bill, "AN ACT Increasing Minimum Wages."

Amend said Bill by striking out in the 10th line (8th line of L. D.) the following: "\$2 per hour starting October 15, ±969-1971" and inserting in place thereof the following: '\$1.80 per hour starting from October 15, ±969 1971, to October 15, 1972 and thereafter \$2 per hour'

Further amend said Bill by striking out in the last line, before the Statement of Fact, the underlined figure "\$2" and inserting in place thereof the underlined figure '<u>\$1.80</u>'

Statement of Fact

The purpose of this amendment is to provide a graduated increase in the minimum wage. Effective October 15, 1971 the minimum wage will be \$1.80 per hour, and on October 15, 1972, it will be \$2.

Nursing home and hospital employees will have a similar step increase except that the maximum for such employees will be \$1.80 per hour.
