AN ACT Increasing Assistance to War Orphans in Securing Higher
Education.

Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine, as follows:

R. S., T. 20, § 3212, amended. The first sentence of section 3212 of Title 20 of the Revised Statutes is amended to read as follows:

In order to assist any person qualifying as an orphan of a veteran in accordance with section 3211 in securing higher education, the department shall pay, for any person which it finds eligible for such assistance, a maximum of ~~\$150~~ \$300 per year, for a period of time not exceeding 8 semesters of attendance nor exceeding 6 consecutive academic years from the date of first entrance, towards the cost of such higher education.

STATEMENT OF FACT

The purpose of this bill is to increase the assistance to war orphans in securing higher education from \$150 to \$300.

FISCAL NOTE

It is estimated that the increased cost of this legislation will be \$18,000 per year.
