SENATE AMENDMENT "A" to S. P. 20, L. D. 48, Bill, "AN ACT  
Relating to Disposition of Portion of Fees Collected by Maine State  
Park and Recreation Commission."

Amend said Bill by inserting at the beginning of the first  
line after the enacting clause the underlined abbreviation and figure  
'Sec. 1.'

Further amend said Bill by striking out all of the last  
underlined sentence before the Statement of Fact.


Further amend said Bill by inserting at the end, before the  
Statement of Fact, the following:

'Sec. 2. Effective date. This Act shall become effective  
January 1, 1972.'
