AN ACT Relating to Disposition of Portion of Fees Collected by Maine
State Park and Recreation Commission.

Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine, as follows:

R. S., T. 12, § 602, sub-§ 4, amended. Subsection 4 of section 602 of Title 12 of the Revised Statutes is amended by adding a new paragraph at the end, to read as follows:

Fifteen per cent of all fees received under this subsection for services rendered to the public on any state park and any park under state control located in a municipality shall be paid to such municipality. If such park is located in more than one municipality, such payment shall be divided equally among the municipalities involved. The commission shall increase the fees provided by this subsection to an amount which will reflect the loss of revenue to the General Fund of the State.

STATEMENT OF FACT

The purpose of this bill is to financially aid the municipalities in which state parks are located.
