STATE OF MAINE

IN THE YEAR OF OUR LORD NINETEEN HUNDRED SEVENTY-ONE

AN ACT Relating to Offices of Health and Welfare Department Located Outside of Augusta.

Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine, as follows:

R. S., T. 22, § 5-A, additional. Title 22 of the Revised Statutes is amended by adding a new section 5-A, to read as follows:

§ 5-A. Location of offices

Offices established in a municipality outside of Augusta to aid in carrying out the duties and functions of this Title shall be located, to the greatest extent possible, within the confines of a single building in such municipality.

STATEMENT OF FACT

Whenever offices of the Department of Health and Welfare are established outside of Augusta they shall be located in one building in any one municipality for the convenience of the general public and those citizens of Maine who receive aid through the department.
