STATE OF MAINE

IN THE YEAR OF OUR LORD NINETEEN HUNDRED SEVENTY-ONE

AN ACT Relating to Time Change of Enrollment in a Political Party.

Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine, as follows:

- R. S., T. 21, § 134, sub-§ 3, amended. Subsection 3 of section 134 of Title 21 of the Revised Statutes, is amended to read as follows:
- 3. Restrictions during change of enrollment. A voter may not vote at a caucus or primary election within 6 3 months after filing an application to change his enrollment, except as provided in subsection 4.

STATEMENT OF FACT

The purpose of the bill is to permit a voter to change his enrollment in a political party and vote within 3 months of his application rather than 6 months.
