AN ACT Regulating the Operation of Snowmobiles in Unorganized
Territory During Deer Season.

Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine, as follows:

R. S., T. 12, § 1986, additional. Title 12 of the Revised Statutes is amended by adding a new section 1986, to read as follows:

§ 1986. Unorganized territory during hunting season

It shall be unlawful for any person to operate a snowmobile in the forests or upon the waters of any unorganized territory of this State during the open season on deer. This section shall not apply on Sunday, to a law enforcement officer or as provided in section 1985.

STATEMENT OF FACT

The purpose of this bill is to regulate the operation of snowmobiles in the unorganized territory during the deer hunting season in the interest of conservation.
