IN THE YEAR OF OUR LORD NINETEEN HUNDRED SEVENTY-ONE

AN ACT Permitting Counties to Raise Money for Public Ambulance Service.

Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine, as follows:

R. S., T. 30, c. 11, additional. Title 30 of the Revised Statutes is amended by adding a new chapter 11, to read as follows:

CHAPTER 11

AMBULANCE SERVICE

§ 1351. Ambulance service

A county may raise or appropriate money for the purpose of providing public ambulance service, and the county commissioners may elect to operate, maintain or discontinue such service in all or any portion of a county and may govern all or any portion of the operation of such service or allow the same to be done by others.

STATEMENT OF FACT

The purpose of this bill is to permit counties to raise money for providing public ambulance service for the benefit of the people.
