COMMITTEE AMENDMENT " A " to H. P. 32, L. D. 56, Bill, "AN ACT Designating November 11th as Armistice Day."

Amend said Bill by striking out all of the last underlined paragraph before the Statement of Fact and inserting in place thereof the following:

'November 11th of each year shall be designated as Armistice Day and public schools in this State are encouraged to set aside a portion of the school day to enlighten and inform the youth of Maine of the events that transpired in World War I, a critical conflict for world freedom.'

Statement of Fact

The purpose of this amendment is to make commemorative ceremonies in public schools permissive rather than mandatory.
