STATE OF MAINE

IN THE YEAR OF OUR LORD NINETEEN HUNDRED SEVENTY-ONE

AN ACT Providing for Penalty for Failure to Pay Workmen's Compensation.

Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine, as follows:

R. S., T. 39, § 72, additional. Title 39 of the Revised Statutes is amended by adding a new section 72, to read as follows:

§ 72. Failure to pay

Failure to pay compensation under this Act shall be punishable by a fine of not more than \$500 or by imprisonment for not more than one year, or by both.

STATEMENT OF FACT

The purpose of this bill is to provide for a penalty for failure to pay Workmen's Compensation.
