STATE OF MAINE

IN THE YEAR OF OUR LORD NINETEEN HUNDRED SEVENTY-ONE

AN ACT Relating to Budgets of Recipients of Old Age Assistance.

Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine, as follows:

R. S., T. 22, § 3404, amended. Section 3404 of Title 22 of the Revised Statutes, as amended, is further amended by adding at the end the following new paragraph:

Any increase in social security benefits or the amount paid for rental in low rental housing shall be disregarded in making a budget for a recipient of old age assistance.

STATEMENT OF FACT

The purpose of this bill is to prevent a decrease in old age assistance to those who obtain an increase in social security benefits or who live in public housing.
