HOUSE AMENDMENT " A " to S. P. 32, L. D. 65, Bill, "AN ACT
Relating to the Number of Signatures Required on Nomination Papers."

Amend said Bill by inserting at the end, before the
Statement of Fact, the following:

'Sec. 3. R. S., T. 21, §492, sub-§5-A, additional. Section
492 of Title 21 of the Revised Statutes, as amended, is further
amended by adding a new subsection 5-A, to read as follows:

5-A. Independent candidates. For independent candidates it
must be signed by a number of registered independent voters equal
to at least 1% of the number of votes cast for Governor at
the last gubernatorial election in the electoral division which is
to make the nomination, but in no case less than 25.'

Statement of Fact

Independent candidates and voters would be put on a separate
status by this amendment.
