## STATE OF MAINE HOUSE OF REPRESENTATIVES 105TH LEGISLATURE

HOUSE AMENDMENT "B" to S. P. 32, L. D. 65, Bill, "AN ACT Relating to the Number of Signatures Required on Nomination Papers."

Amend said Bill by striking out all of the last paragraph, before the Statement of Fact, and inserting in place thereof the following:

'5. Number of signatures required. It must be signed by a number of registered but unenrolled voters equal to at least 1% of the number of votes cast for Governor at the last gubernatorial election in the electoral division which is to make the nomination, but in no case less than 25.'

Independent candidates and voters would be put on a separate status by this amendment.
