**AN ACT** Relating to Open Season for Bass by Ice Fishing.

---

Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine, as follows:

**R. S., T. 12, § 2651, amended.** Section 2651 of Title 12 of the Revised Statutes, as amended, is further amended by adding at the end the following new paragraph:

Unless otherwise provided by rule and regulation, it shall be lawful to take black bass through the ice during the same period that it is lawful to take salmon and trout.

STATEMENT OF FACT

The purpose of this bill is to provide ice fishing for black bass. Such fishing will not be detrimental to the fishing for black bass in the summer.
