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RESOLVE, Designating Certain Bridge Across the Penobscot River as  
"Levi Lancaster Memorial Bridge."

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"Levi Lancaster Memorial Bridge;" designated. Resolved: That in recognition of the unselfish service rendered to the State of Maine by the late Levi Lancaster the bridge across the Penobscot in the Town of Lincoln be named the "Levi Lancaster Memorial Bridge;" and be it further

Resolved: That appropriate plaques designating the name of this bridge be maintained by the State Highway Commission at such location on the approach to or on the bridge itself as the State Highway Commission may select.

STATEMENT OF FACT

Mr. Lancaster was in charge of the roads in the central Maine area for many years. The purpose of this resolve is to honor his unselfish service.
