STATE OF MAINE

IN THE YEAR OF OUR LORD NINETEEN HUNDRED SEVENTY-ONE

AN ACT Providing for Date of Packaging of Certain Refrigerated Products.

Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine, as follows:

R. S., T. 7, c. 103, sub-c. X-A, additional. Chapter 103 of Title 7 of the Revised Statutes is amended by adding a new subchapter X-A to read as follows:

SUBCHAPTER X-A REFRIGERATED PRODUCTS

§ 1011. Refrigerated products

All packaged bakery products, dairy products, refrigerated meat products, refrigerated poultry products, refrigerated fish products, packaged in the State of Maine for retail or wholesale trade must bear on the package the date of packaging in uncoded form.

STATEMENT OF FACT

The purpose of this bill is to provide further protection to the consumer who purchases refrigerated and other foods.
