COMMITTEE AMENDMENT " A " to H. P. 48, L. D. 81, Bill, "AN
ACT Defining Secondary Schools."

Amend said Bill by inserting before the enacting clause
the following:

'Emergency preamble. Whereas, Acts of the Legislature do not
become effective until 90 days after adjournment unless enacted
as emergencies; and

Whereas, certain school administrative units have already
authorized technical centers; and

Whereas, the following legislation is vitally necessary
to pay construction costs in lump sums to such units under
the Revised Statutes, Title 20, section 3460; and

Whereas, in the judgment of the Legislature, these facts
create an emergency within the meaning of the Constitution of
Maine, and require the following legislation as immediately
necessary for the preservation of the public peace, health
and safety; now, therefore, '

Further amend said Bill by inserting at the end, before
the statement of fact, the following:

'Emergency clause. In view of the emergency cited in the
preamble, this Act shall take effect when approved.'
