## STATE OF MAINE HOUSE OF REPRESENTATIVES 105TH LEGISLATURE

COMMITTEE AMENDMENT " A " to H. P. 49, L. D. 83, Bill, "AN ACT to Clarify the Laws of the Department of Veterans Services."

Amend said Bill in section 1 by striking out all of the 4th and 5th lines (3rd and 4th in L. D.) and inserting in place thereof the following:

'All employees of the department, with the exception of the clerical and other than full time, permanent personnel, shall be war veterans.'

Further amend said Bill in section 3 by inserting in the 5th line (same in L. D.) after the underlined word "used" the underlined words 'for burial'.

## Statement of Fact

Present law provides that all employees of the department other than clerical personnel must be war veterans. The amendment above to section 1 of the bill would give some latitude to the department in hiring seasonal, part-time or project laboring personnel at Veterans Memorial Cemetery in the event veterans are not readily available for such positions. However, full time, permanent positions would require the services of war veterans.
