IN THE YEAR OF OUR LORD NINETEEN HUNDRED SEVENTY-ONE

RESOLVE, Regulating Fishing in Mousam Lake, Square Pond and Wilson Pond in York County.

Mousam Lake, York County; fishing regulated. Resolved: That the Commissioner of Inland Fisheries and Game is directed to issue a rule and regulation closing Mousam Lake, in the Towns of Acton and Shapleigh, York County, to the taking of smelts, except by single hook and line, and closed to all other fishing until February 1st and providing for no size or bag limit on pickerel and bass; and be it further

Square Pond, York County; fishing regulated. Resolved: That the Commissioner of Inland Fisheries and Game is directed to issue a rule and regulation closing Square Pond in the Towns of Acton and Shapleigh, York County, to all fishing until February 1st and providing no size or bag limit on pickerel or bass; and be it further

Wilson Pond, York County; fishing regulated. Resolved: That the Commissioner of Inland Fisheries and Game be directed to issue a rule and regulation closing Wilson Pond in the Town of Acton, York County, to the taking of smelts, except by single hook and line, and closed to all other fishing until February 1st.
