SENATE AMENDMENT " B " to S. P. 57, L. D., 96, Resolution,
"Proposing an Amendment to the Constitution Providing for Annual
Legislative Sessions"

Amend said Resolution by inserting after the 17th line
(same in L.D) the following new paragraph:

'Beginning with the year 1974 and each even-numbered
year thereafter for a session of not more than sixty calendar
days, the Legislature shall consider only appropriation bills,
revenue bills necessary therefor, such Acts, resolves or orders
as may be necessary to provide for the expense and conduct of
the session and such matters as the majority of the legislative
leaders including all political parties deem to be of an
emergency nature.'

The purpose of this amendment is to limit the matters that
the Legislature may consider in the even-numbered years.
