**AN ACT Appropriating Funds for Information Center at Eastern Terminal
of Interstate 95.**

Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine, as follows:

Appropriation. There is appropriated from the Unappropriated Surplus of the General Fund the sum of \$95,000 for the construction of an information center to be located at the eastern terminal of Interstate 95 at or near Houlton.

The location of such information center shall be determined by the Highway Commission and the construction shall be made by the Department of Economic Development under the direction and supervision of the Bureau of Public Improvements.

STATEMENT OF FACT

An information center is extremely important to Maine to provide tourist information to Maine's tourists who enter Maine at the eastern terminal of Interstate 95.
