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**AN ACT** Relating to Record of Plans by Registers of Deeds.

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Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine, as follows:

R. S., T. 33, § 652, repealed and replaced. Section 652 of Title 33 of the Revised Statutes is repealed and the following enacted in place thereof:

§ 652. Record of plans

The several registers, with the approval of the State Archivist, shall establish, and thereafter adhere to, reasonable requirements and procedures for the recording of plans. Such requirements may impose limitations on the size or material, or both, of plans to be eligible for record and in every case shall be designed to safely keep and preserve the original plan as recorded, while affording the public reasonable opportunity to examine the same or a legible reproduction thereof. Each register shall make a suitable index of all plans on record in his office.

STATEMENT OF FACT

The purpose of this bill is to revise and make more efficient the recordation of plans in the offices of registers of deeds.
