COMMITTEE AMENDMENT "A" to H. P. 61, L. D. 102, Bill, "AN ACT Relating to Boards of Registration for Certain Municipalities Under Election Laws."

Amend said Bill by inserting at the end before the period (same in L.D.) the following underlined words: 'except that a city or town which has a population of 4,000 to 5,000 may, if they choose, have a board of registration in lieu of a registrar of voters'

Statement of Fact

The purpose of this bill is to make permissive boards of registration under the election laws for municipalities with a population of 4,000 to 5,000. No change for municipalities of 5,000 and over is intended.
