STATE OF MAINE

IN THE YEAR OF OUR LORD NINETEEN HUNDRED SEVENTY-ONE

AN ACT Relating to Boards of Registration for Certain Municipalities
Under Election Laws.

Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine, as follows:

R. S., T. 21, § 43, amended. The first paragraph of section 43 of Title 21 of the Revised Statutes, as amended by section 3 of chapter 398 of the public laws of 1965, is further amended to read as follows:

In a city or town which as a population of 5,000 4,000 or over, a board of registration consisting of 3 members must be appointed as follows: One member nominated by the city committees of each of the 2 major parties and appointed by the municipal officers, and the 3rd member appointed by the Governor with the advice and consent of the Council.

STATEMENT OF FACT

The purpose of this bill is to provide boards of registration under the election laws for municipalities with a population of 4,000 or over rather than with a population of 5,000 or over.
