**AN ACT Repealing the Licensing of Guides and Permits for Camp Trip  
Leaders Under Fish and Game Laws.**

---

Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine, as follows:

**Sec. 1. R. S., T. 12, § 2053, repealed.** Section 2053 of Title 12 of the Revised Statutes, as repealed and replaced by section 2 of chapter 241 and as last amended by chapter 524, both of the public laws of 1969, is repealed.

**Sec. 2. R. S., T. 12, § 2054, repealed.** Section 2054 of Title 12 of the Revised Statutes, as enacted by section 56 of chapter 425 of the public laws of 1969, is repealed.

STATEMENT OF FACT

The law relating to licensing of guides under fish and game laws is relatively unenforceable and such guides are often unavailable when needed. By repealing permits for camp trip leaders Maine will also encourage out-of-state campers to come into Maine for canoe trips.
