STATE OF MAINE

IN THE YEAR OF OUR LORD NINETEEN HUNDRED SEVENTY-ONE

AN ACT Relating to Judges' Instructions in Comparative Negligence Actions.

Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine, as follows:

R. S., T. 14, § 156, amended. The 3rd paragraph of section 156 of Title 14 of the Revised Statutes, as enacted by section 1 of chapter 399 of the public laws of 1969, is repealed as follows:

The trial judge shall read the foregoing a paragraphs to the jury in their entirety.

STATEMENT OF FACT

The purpose of this bill is to prevent confusion in the minds of jurors in comparative negligence cases.
