COMMITTEE AMENDMENT "A" to H. P. 70, L. D. 111, Bill, "AN ACT Relating to Falsely Assuming to be a Municipal Police Officer."

Amend said Bill, in the Title, by striking out the words "a Municipal Police" and inserting in place thereof the word 'an'

Further amend said Bill by striking out everything after the enacting clause and inserting in place thereof the following:

'R. S., T. 17, §1451, repealed and replaced. Section 1451 of Title 17 of the Revised Statutes is repealed and the following enacted in place thereof:

§1451. Falsely assuming to be an officer

Whoever falsely assumes to be or impersonates a justice of the peace, notary public, health officer, state humane agent or any law enforcement officer, or who falsely acts as such, or who requires anyone to aid him in a matter pertaining to the duties of any such office which he does not hold, shall be punished by a fine of not more than \$500 or by imprisonment for not more than 11 months, or by both.

Statement of Fact

The intent of this amendment is to include all law enforcement officers as well as municipal police officers.
