AN ACT Relating to Operation of the Livermore Falls Water District.

Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine, as follows:

P. & S. L., 1907, c. 390, § 15, sub-§ IV, repealed. Subsection IV of section 15 of chapter 390 of the private and special laws of 1907 is repealed as follows:

IV. If any surplus remains at the end of the year it may be paid to the town of East Livermore.

STATEMENT OF FACT

The purpose of this bill is to provide for the operation of the Livermore Falls Water District in an efficient manner. If any surplus results from such operation, there could be a reduction in the rates charged by the district.
