SENATE AMENDMENT "A" to H. P. 83, L. D. 123, RESOLUTION,
Proposing an Amendment to the Constitution Raising the Municipal
Debt Limit from Seven and One-half to Fifteen Percent."

Amend said Resolution in the 9th line (8th in L. D.) by
striking out the word "regular" and inserting in place thereof
the words 'regular State'

Further amend said Bill in the 10th line (8th in L.D.) by
striking out the words "of said city or town" and inserting in
place thereof the words 'ef-said-city-or-town'

Statement of Fact

The purpose of this amendment is to relate the municipal
debt limit to the State valuation rather than the municipal
valuation.
